


**CITY OF THROCKMORTON
CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
OCTOBER 11, 2016**

1. Mayor Will Carroll called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the following council members present: Corey Keeter, Geneva Rodgers, and Judy Jackson. Council member Brad Bellah was absent. Others present were: Melanie Gober, City Secretary. Will Carroll gave the invocation.
2. The Council reviewed and approved the minutes from the September 13th, 2016 regular meeting.

3. There was no one present for Citizens Participation. Mayor Carroll reported that street repairs are continuing to be done due to the excessive rains causing erosion; Commissioner Wells has agreed to use his equipment to dig the 4.5 foot hole that is needed to finish the installation of the basketball goal at the City Park, when that is done, the requirements of the grant will be met and the City will receive the retention money that is being held; a flow meter at the water plant has gone out, Jimmy is in the process of getting it repaired/replaced; by July 2017 the City will be required to upgrade our Sewer Plant according to TCEQ requirements, it's not a major project but it will take time and money, an extension of time is in the works but there is no guarantee we will receive it.
4. The results of the October 11th, 2016 Economic Development Meeting was discussed. The budget for the Economic Development Corporation was approved by the members of the Economic Development Board.
