## CITY OF THROCKMORTON MEETING MINUTES May 9, 2017

- Mayor Will Carroll called the city council meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with council members Judy Jackson, Corey Keeter, Ricky Escalon, Susie Oliver, and Brad Bellah present. Also present were Melanie Gober-City Secretary, and Kim Bundy-Asst. Secretary. Invocation was given by Mayor Carroll.
- 3. Statement of Elected Officer and the Oath of Office was administered to newly elected and re-elected council members duly elected for the purposes of the May 6, 2017 General Election, pursuant to ORDINANCE 2017-03 issued on March 7, 2017 cancelling the election that was scheduled to be held on May 6, 2017. Melanie Gober administered the Oath of Office to Will Carroll, Mayor then Mayor Carroll administered the Oath of Office to Ricky Escalon-Place1 and Susie Oliver-Place 2.
- Citizens Participation: there was no one present for citizen's participation.
  Mayor Carroll reported:
  - a.) City Pool has been drained, cleaned and any necessary repairs have been made. The baby was cleaned and repainted; he informed the council that the paint was donated by one of the City's vendors so the City was saved that expense. He reported that the lifeguards and the pool manager have been hired and the pool is ready for Splash Day on June 1<sup>st</sup>.
  - b.) Joe Ed Barrington has volunteered along with others to repair and put the pier back at the lake.
  - c.) David Welborn has been hired again this summer to repair streets. He will start May 22<sup>nd</sup>.
  - d.) The airport project is ongoing. The meeting between the Marine Corp. Winged Services Division, Mayor Carroll and TX DOT was rescheduled for May 23<sup>rd</sup> in Wichita Falls due to weather complications.
  - e.) The outside of the lake dam has been cleared of brush and debris and sprayed; the inside will be sprayed as soon as possible.
- Old Business:
  - a.) Brad Bellah has received two bids regarding the repairs that are to be done to the Fire Hall and he is waiting on one more bid before presenting them to the council.
  - b.) Corey Keeter reported that the fish habitat project is progressing; more have been placed in the lake since last meeting. Corey Keeter and Mr. Barrington are building more to be installed as soon as they are completed.
- Purchasing a new work truck was discussed with no action being taken at this time.

All Council Members in favor. Motion carried 5 - 0.
