There was an accident that involved both the 2005 & 2016 Chevrolet trucks. There was damage to the back fender of the 2016 truck, it was repaired and insurance covered all repair costs except for the \$500.00 deductible; We are still waiting on the manufactured fiber chips to be delivered to the park. The chips have been ordered and will be delivered as soon as possible; Mayor Carroll has been in contact with the Engineer that will be assisting us to make the updates that TCEQ is requiring at the Waste Water Treatment Plant. We are still waiting to hear if we received the Community Development Block Grant, if received, those funds will be used to pay for the updates.
- Cameron Gulley, CPA, presented the City of Throckmorton's GASB 68 and 2015-2016 Audit Report. After going through the complete financial reports of the audit, Mr. Gulley reported that the City's audit disclosed all financials to be in compliance according to what is required to be reported in accordance with generally accepted Government Auditing Standards.
