TAX REMITTANCE INFORMATION

LODGING ESTABLISHMENT INFORMATION:

Every person providing transient lodging remuneration must collect a tax of six percent (6X) on the rent paid, unless the lodger qualifies for an allowable term or personal status exemption. All allowable term and personal status exemption. All allowable term and personal status exemptions for the local Hotel Occupancy Tax are presented on the second page of this form. The Hotel Occupancy tax is due and payable to the City monthly, on or before the 20th day of the month next succeeding the monthly period in which the tax s\was collected. For timely payment, a discount in the amount of one percent (1X) of the Tax may be deducted. For failure to pay by the due date, the lodging provider is subject to paying a penalty on the Tax due as outlined below. Penalties will be assessed based on the date of receipt (for hand-delivered payments) or postmark (for mailed payments). This return is subject to audit.
