



**CITY OF THROCKMORTON**  
**MEETING MINUTES**  
**April 16<sup>th</sup>, 2015**

1. Mayor Will Carroll called the city council meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with council members Tamra Gray, Judy Jackson, and Corey Keeter present. Absent were Geneva Rodgers and Troy Batts. Also present was Cameron Gulley-Auditor, Kim Bundy, and Melanie Gober. Mayor Carroll gave the invocation.

Mayor Carroll reported he talked with the City of Graham and although we are in Stage IV water restriction the Pool will be allowed to open since it is essential to the well-being of the community, but private pools are not allowed as stated in the Stage IV water restriction policy. He also discussed that we will hire two seasonal hands this summer, a Pool Manager and Lifeguards. An ad has been put in the paper and on Facebook. The lake project was discussed and there will be a City employee available to help at the lake every Monday until the project is finished and at other times when the employees aren't busy with City operations.
4. The Cost of Living increase was discussed and tabled until a later date.
5. Council Members discussed the renewal of the Emergency Water Contract with the City of Graham, no action taken until the contract is received from Graham.
6. Cameron Gulley, CPA, presented the City of Throckmorton's 2013-2014 Audit Report. After going through complete financial reports of the audit, Mr. Gulley reported that the City's audit disclosed all financials to be in compliance according to what is required to be reported in accordance with generally accepted Government Auditing Standards.
