PUBLIC NOTICE LEAD AND COPPER MONITORING

The City of Throckmorton-PWS ID No. 2240001, has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Chapter 30, Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to monitor for Lead and Copper and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ. During January 1, 2012-December 31, 2014, we did not complete all monitoring and/or reporting for lead and copper, and therefore TCEQ cannot be sure of the safety of your drinking water during that time.

We are working to correct the problem by taking samples our public water system to an approved lab for Lead and Copper analysis and sending the lab results to TCEQ within the required time frame.
